Will donating allow me to have a "free funeral"?

No, donation is not free, but it is considerably cheaper than a typical funeral or cremation!

Why is donation not free?

Your funds support the funeral director who transports your remains and writes the death certificate. CAPHIL sometimes has monetary gifts that subsidize these costs. Please contact us to determine if funds are available. Skeletal donation is another chance to tell your life story to the world!
